The Need to Discuss Behavior and Our Treatment of Each Other

Dear Parents,

The faculty and staff at Queen of All Saints School is asking that you talk to your child/ren about how they are treating their fellow classmates and the other students in the building. We are starting to see an increase in the children making unkind comments to other students such as, "I don't want him/her on our team", "Oh, he/she takes FOREVER to finish their homework", "I won't wear that anymore since he/she has one". These comments and the numerous others that I could list are hurtful to the students and to our school community. I am asking that all parents please take some time and talk to your child/ren about their attitude/behavior toward other children in the building. Also, please encourage your child/ren that when they hear or see someone being unkind to please let an adult know. This would not be tattling it is telling. Tattling is when you tell an adult what someone has done so as to get that person in trouble. Telling is when you tell an adult what someone has done in an effort to stop the behavior before someone gets hurt. I appreciate your help in this situation. We all need to work together in making Queen of All Saints School a nurturing environment for all of our students.
