We would like to welcome Miss Erin Breen who will be substituting for Mrs. Olson, 5th grade science, for the remainder of her time away from school.

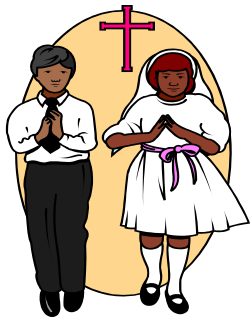
