- The completed application should include a check or money order for \$21 payable to Private School Aid Service. No cash.

Please Note: All copies need to be on regular 8 1/2 x 11 paper.

- Copies of 2009 W-2 Wage and Tax Statement Forms, 2009 1099/1099R or 1098 Forms.
- Copies of all pages and schedules of the 2009 Federal Income Tax Return Forms. **If you have not filed your 2009 taxes please include a copy of your most recent form 1040, 1040A, or 1040 EZ with all schedules.**
- Section L of the application (Explanations) can also be used to describe any clarifications, dramatic changes in income from 2009 to 2010, special circumstances, etc.
- Documentation of TOTAL AMOUNTS received in 2009 for all Non-Taxable Income.
