All orders are due by Tuesday, February 23rd.

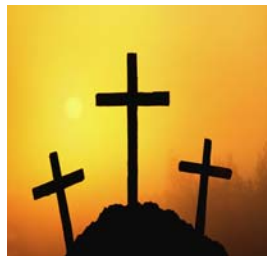

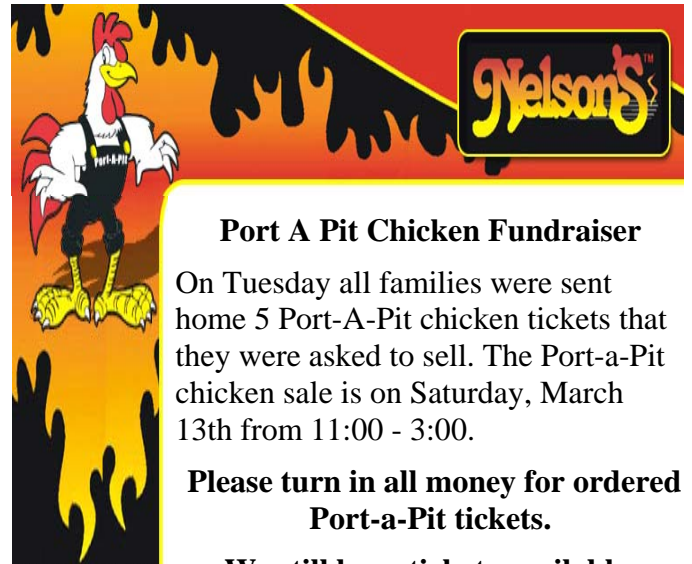
