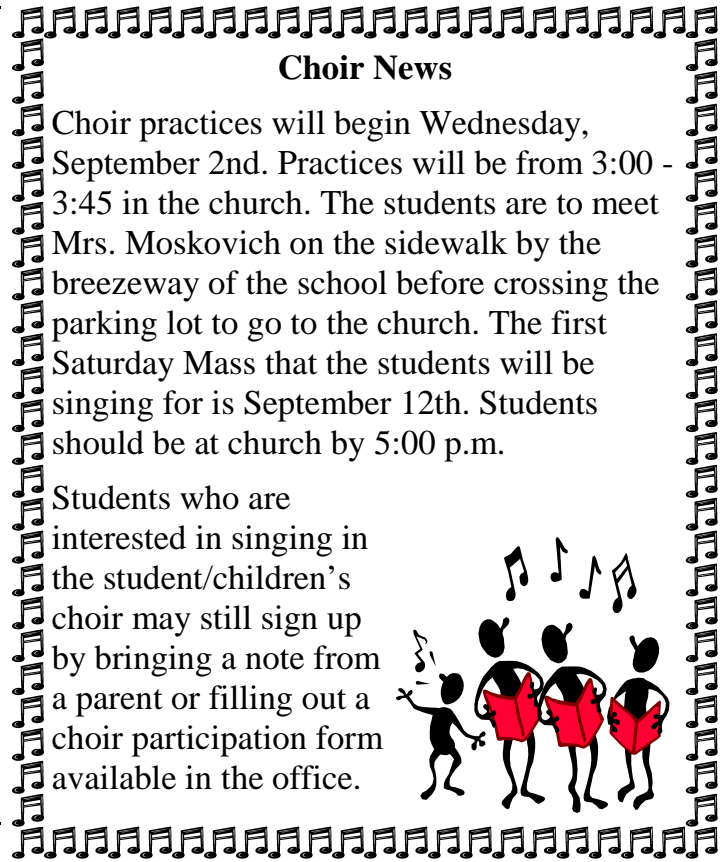

SCRIP will be sold after all masses the Weekend of September 26 and 27.

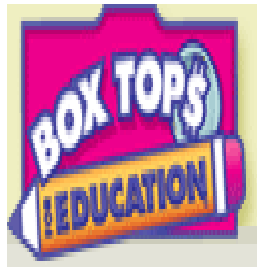
The SCRIP office is open every morning that school is in session.
