Market Day Incentive:

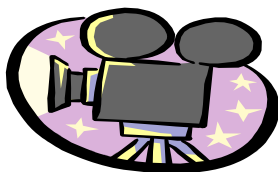

The Living Rosary, led by Queen of All Saints students, will be prayed during the month of October at 2:15 p.m. in the church.

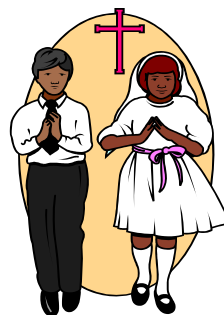
