The 5th/6th volleyball tournament at Marquette has been cancelled for Sunday 10/18/09 due to teams not being able to attend.

Currently, our State Accredited High School, with its recognized PL221 Exemplary status, boasts the highest State GQE Exam scores in Northwest Indiana. The scores reported by the DOE in 2009 suggest Marquette ranks in the top 3% of all state high schools. The following data on the 2008 GQE Math/English for high school-2008/2009 supports this claim:

- Marquette Catholic High school: 96%
- Andean High School: 83%
- Bishop Noll High School: 72%
- Valparaiso High School: 83%
- Wheeler High School: 83%
- Chesterton High School: 79%
- Michigan City High School: 56%
- LaLumiere: No results- non-accredited by the State of Indiana
