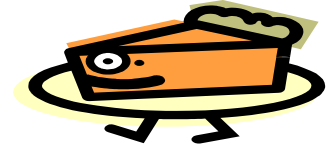


Parent Meeting for Confirmation candidates is this Saturday, November 14th at 10:30 a.m. in the church.
