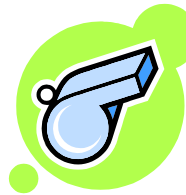

If you still have pie orders out please turn them into the office ASAP. Remember that payment for the pies is due when the order is placed.

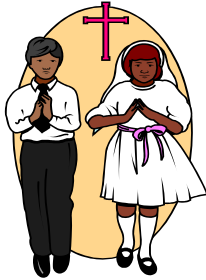
