The Children Will Be Singing!!!!!!

The Queen of All Saints Christmas program is scheduled for Tuesday, December 15th. The children will be putting on two performances at 1:30, with doors opening at 1:00 and at 7:00, with doors opening at 6:00 p.m. Children who arrive prior to 6:30 for the evening performance are reminded that they must remain in the gymnasium with their parents until 6:30 when they may go to their classrooms. Students are expected to be at both performances.

The 8th grade students need to be prepared to dress in all black for their performance. PreKindergarten and Kindergarten need to bring mittens or gloves. Some students in other grades have been asked to dress in specific apparel for their grade's performance and they know who they are. All students, regardless of needing to change for the performance except for 8th grade, are asked to wear their "Sunday Best" to school. 8th grade students may choose to wear their school uniform or dress up. "Sunday Best" means:

- **Students may wear shoes that are appropriate for their outfit.
- **The students must bring tennis shoes to wear for recess.
- **Skirts and dresses must be of appropriate school uniform length. Dresses/skirts must be to the knee.
- **Boys: Shirts must be tucked in.
- **No Cargo pants or Jeans.



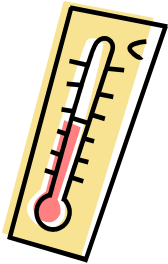

Dress Code Reminders

Just a reminder about some dress code policies that some students seem to have forgotten:

Colors for shirts are: Navy blue, light blue and white. All shirts are to have a collar

Boys haircuts: above the eyebrows, trimmed over the ears, and just below the hairline in the back.

Cargo pants: Cargo pants are not to be worn to school.

Boots: Boots may be worn to school but students must change to tennis shoes or dress shoes before school.

T-shirts: If t-shirts or long sleeved shirts are worn under a student's polo shirt the shirt is to be of school color and not have writing on it that can be seen through the shirt.

Belts: Belts are to be worn by all students in grades 2 - 8. Shirts are to be tucked in.
