The Queen of All Saints Christmas program is scheduled for tomorrow, December 6th. The children will be putting on two performances at 1:30, with doors opening at 1:00 and at 7:00, with doors opening at 6:00 p.m. Children who arrive prior to 6:30 for the evening performance are reminded that they must remain in the gymnasium with their parents until 6:30 when they may go to their classrooms. Students are expected to be at both performances.

It is requested that students in grades 3 and 4 have the girls be prepared to dress as angels and for the boys to dress as shepherds for their performance. The 8th grade students need to be prepared to dress in all black for their performance. All students, regardless of needing to change for the performance except for 8th grade, are asked to wear their "Sunday Best" to school. 8th grade students may choose to wear their school uniform or dress up. "Sunday Best" means:

- **Students may wear shoes that are appropriate for their outfit.
- **The students must bring tennis shoes to wear for recess.
- **Skirts and dresses must be of appropriate school uniform length.
- **Boys: Shirts must be tucked in.
